





Relationship between Unemployment and Degree Completion

Data from the government proves that higher education degree completion is important for job seekers; he unemployment rate was more than twice as high for persons without a high school diploma than for persons with an Associate's degree. That gap widens to three times in comparison to persons who hold a Bachelor's degree. The unemployment rate for persons with Master's, professional and doctoral degrees was the lowest, at 2-4 percent.





Salary and Degree Completion

Better, a completed undergraduate or graduate degree will not only help you get a job, it has been statistically proven on average to boost pay.





Obtaining Career Goals

Indeed, it has been shown that skills that are often honed during a student's higher education incorporate proficiencies that will help them fully reach his or her respective career goals. 




